2016 LANDSMAN ZINFANDEL

The 2016 vintage capped a 4-year streak where we thought it just couldn't get any better. Ideal conditions throughout the growing season brought the grapes to peak ripeness, resulting in vivid fruit flavors and soft, supple tannins.

ABOUT THE WINE:

Landsman Zinfandel 2016 is made from a single vineyard in Lodi, California. Lodi—located in the Sacramento Delta region east of Napa Valley—is California's best known wine region for Zinfandel grapes, which have been farmed there for more than 150 years. Some of the early "old vines" are still visible today, producing minute amounts of intensely flavored grapes. Zinfandel is typically very fruit-forward and soft textured, perfect for early drinking. But it's complex enough to stand up to any steak as well as a variety of dishes typically shared with good friends and family on special occasions.

TASTING NOTES:

After 6 years working with this Zinfandel vineyard, we have developed a good understanding of its unique terroir. The wine is already showing lovely plum and black cherry flavors, highlighted by spice and floral notes reminiscent of violets. Silky, smooth tannins give it classic elegance. This is not your average Zinfandel! But rather, a fine example of why the Lodi appellation is renowned for some of the best Zinfandel in California.
