ABOUT THE WINE:

There is not much Roussanne, one of the Rhone Valley's premier white grapes, grown in California. These grapes are sourced from grower Larry Mettler's vineyard in Lodi. Whole cluster pressed then fermented in neutral oak with native yeast, the wine was bottled after relatively short barrel aging (6 months), which we believe maintains purity of fruit.

TASTING NOTES:

Mensch Roussanne serves up a wonderful mineral core with bright acidity for good structure. Hints of stone fruit, citrus and jasmine give it the kind of quality you'd expect in a wine that costs twice as much. It is regularly among our highest rated white wines, even though it is our least costly.
