2018 Covenant Israel Cabernet Sauvignon

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

ABOUT THE WINE:

This is the first varietal Cabernet Sauvignon produced by Covenant Israel. The grapes are sourced from Dany Maor's vineyard in the Golan Heights at Tel Faris. We have often used some of Dany's Cabernet Sauvignon grapes in our BLUE C Adom. But in 2018, we decided to select only the best barrels from the free run wine and dedicate to it the varietal that we are best known for with our Napa Valley wines from California. As with our Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon, this wine is fermented with indigenous yeast and aged exclusively in French oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES:

Covenant Israel Cabernet Sauvignon has its own distinct character, clearly reflecting the terroir of the Golan Heights. Big, meaty aromas kick off in the nose, followed by pretty plum and cherry notes. On the palate, the wine serves up a complex array of red fruit, herb and spice with toasty oak topping off the finish. It rates among our best wines and should age beautifully to reveal even more layers of flavor in the future.
