ABOUT THE SPIRIT:

Double-Edged Sword has proven to be one of the most sought after and rare bottlings we've ever produced. Inspired by their affinity for fine brandy, Covenant winemakers Jeff Morgan and Jonathan Hajdu were determined to craft their own. This fourth batch is produced exclusively from Chenin Blanc fermented at Covenant Winery. After distillation, the brandy is aged in Covenant's French oak wine barrels. As with the previous vintages, Double-Edged Sword Batch 5780 continues to be a small-lot production of only two barrels. To wield a double-edged sword, you must be a skilled swordsman. The same applies to the way we make Double-Edged Sword Brandy—with finesse, artistry and strength

TASTING NOTES:

This is a smooth-textured spirit, redolent of coffee, camphor, butterscotch and spice. On the palate, it yields long-lasting flavors that evolve to reveal more depth and complexity on the finish. Double-Edged Sword stands up beautifully to a fine cigar but is also highly appreciated with nothing more than the desire to drink an exceedingly refined spirit.
