

## 2024 COVENANT CHARDONNAY LAVAN

#### ABOUT THE WINE:

2024 marks the sixteenth vintage for Covenant Chardonnay Lavan. The wine is made from grapes grown in a small vineyard on Sonoma Mountain. We began working with this vineyard --called Scopus -- back in 2010, when we made a small amount of Chardonnay for the vineyard's owners. We liked the wine so much, that we decided to make Scopus Vineyard the core of our Lavan program the next year.

## TASTING NOTES:

The high-altitude, north-facing Scopus Vineyard harnesses a blend of lush California flavor tempered with cool-climate structure hanging on firm acidity and moderate body. Stone fruit, citrus and spice come to mind on the palate, all marked by the vineyard's classic mineral core. There's a modest hint of toasty oak framing the ensemble, which ends long and fresh.
