Rosé is the world's most versatile wine. It goes with everything from fish, to fowl, to steaks....and most dishes in between! Our RED C Rosé is no exception to the rule.

ABOUT THE WINE:

Covenant RED C Rosé is made from a number of different grape varieties: Pinot Noir, Malbec, Syrah, Zinfandel, Merlot, Petit Verdot and even a tiny bit of Cabernet Sauvignon. The pink juice is bled quickly from tanks immediately after the whole berries are destemmed. Fermentation is in neutral, old French oak barrels. Then the various varietals are blended. The idea is to make a crisp, refreshing wine with just a hint of red fruit and citrus. We also make a rosé of Syrah in Israel called BLUE C. It, too, is bright and fresh tasting.
